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Case study - Home Orchard Farm

The brief for this particular project was to sympathetically extend an existing barn conversion to create a Garden Room.

It was very important that whilst carrying out these works we kept the new building in keeping with the existing, therefore locally sourced roof tiles were used as were the reclaimed bricks when building the retaining walls. The main structure of the garden room was composed from Blue Lias stone and lime mortar, a new green oak roof structure was configured and purpose made hardwood joinery was used.

In side the garden room new under-floor heating was installed to extend on from the main house, electrics including light fittings and sockets were put in and decorations throughout.

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
